A member of the family recites the following blessing while another lights the first candle on the Wreath: Lord God,

Let your blessing come upon us as we light the candle (s) of this wreath. May the wreath and its light be a sign of Christ's promise to bring us salvation. May he come quickly and not delay. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen

Advent: from the Latin word adventus, meaning "coming", is a season of the Christian Church, the period of expectant waiting and preparation for the celebration of the Nativity of Jesus, the period immediately before Christmas
